**Solo Passage Documentation for First Time**  
**Solo Challenge Entry**

New entrants must document that they have made at least one nonstop singlehanded passage **under sail** on the boat being entered in the Challenge, covering a distance sailed of **not less** than 100 statute miles **AND** requiring a passage time of **not less** than 24 hours. If a different boat is used for the solo qualification passage, a complete description of the type of boat is to be provided for GLSS Board of Directors consideration and approval. **Entrants shall complete and submit their solo qualification the race committee chairman of the race they intend to enter at least 3 weeks before the start of the Solo Challenge they are entering or as directed in the Notice of Race or agreed to by the Race Chairman.** The Race Committee has the right to reject any entries for any reason that the Race Committee deems sufficient.
