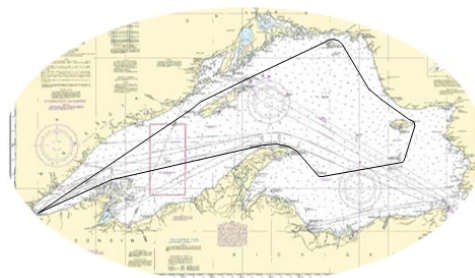


THE INAUGURAL SUPERIOR 600
